

Advanced Courses

Following the COVID-19 pandemic, 25 personal events took place in 2022 (8 Advanced Lecture Courses, 7 joint FEBS-EMBO Lecture Courses, 3 Practical Courses, 2 Practical and Lecture Courses and 5 Workshops) with continued EMBO and IUBMB support. FEBS Advanced Courses provide research updates and teaching from scientific leaders in a particular field and are particularly valuable for early-career researchers. Interaction of




In 2022, grants to course organisers totalled approximately €416,000.
